

PROTOCOLS OF HOME ENTRY



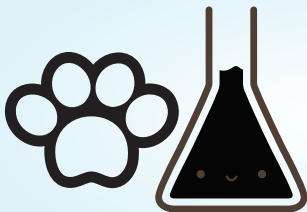
FOR YOUR HYGIENE



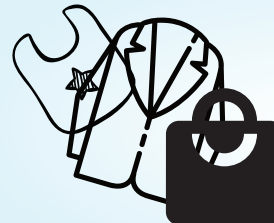
When you return home, try not to touch anything



Take off your shoes



Disinfect your pet's paws if you take him out for a walk



Take off your outer clothing and put it in a laundry bag



Leave bag, wallet, keys, etc. in a box at the entrance



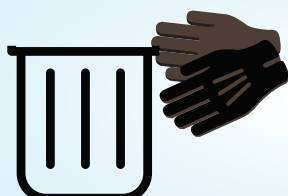
Shower or if you can't, wash all exposed areas well



Wash your phone and glasses with soap and water or alcohol



Clean the surfaces of what you have brought from the outside with bleach before storing



Take off your gloves carefully, throw them away and wash your hands

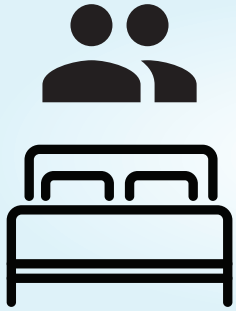


Remember that it is not possible to do a total disinfection, the objective is to reduce the risk

PROTOCOLS OF COEXISTENCE WITH PEOPLE AT RISK

Sleep in
separate bed



Use different baths
and disinfect it
with bleach



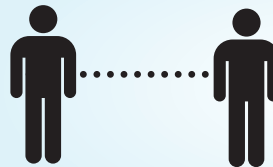
Do not share
towels, cutlery,
glasses, etc.



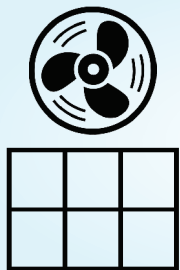
Clean and disinfect
high contact
surfaces daily
(Switches, tables,
chair backs, handles,
etc)



Wash clothes,
sheets and towels
very frequently



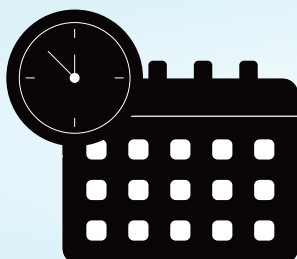
Keep distance,
sleep in
separate rooms



Ventilate your
room often



Call the designated
telephone number
if fever and
difficulty breathing
occur more than
38°



Do not break the quarantine for 2 weeks.
Each exit from home is a
reset of the counter

PROTOCOLS OF HOME EXIT



FOR YOUR HYGIENE



When you go out,
wear a long-sleeved
jacket



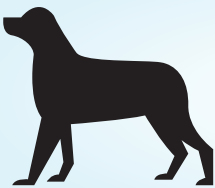
Put your hair up,
Don't wear earring,
bracelets or rings



If you have mask,
put it on at the end,
just before leaving



Try not to
use public
transportation



if you go with
your pet, try not to
rub against surfaces
on the outside



Take disposable
cloths, use them
to cover your
fingers when
touching surfaces.



Wrinkle the
handkerchief and
throw it in a box and
put in garbage can



if you cough sneeze,
do it on your elbow,
not your hands
or in the air.



Try not to
pay in cash, if you
use cash disinfect
your hands



Wash your hands
after touching any
objects and surface
or carry disinfectant
gel.



Don't touch your
face until you have
clean hands



Stay away from
people
